Matthews Design Group (MDG) is presently providing engineering services to Flagler College for a new dormitory building totaling 18,753-square-feet, a c 9,928-square-foot commons building, and an activity and recreation area. MDG is also designing a five story parking garage consisting of 36,987-square-feet with 558 parking spaces. The projects scope of work includes conceptual site planning, construction plan generation, and permitting services. Construction plan elements include site, paving, grading and drainage plans, utility plans, and a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). This project includes permitting with the City of St. Augustine, the St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD), and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. (FDEP)
